

## Directions To Arrowmont From Raleigh NC

From Raleigh and Winston-Salem Take I-40 West.

On I-40 West take exit #27, west of Asheville, on to the Great Smoky Mt Expressway Hwy 74/23. You will see lots of things telling you to get off at exit # 27, like Cherokee, the Smoky MT National Park, Western Carolina University, etc.

From the Expressway Hwy 74/23, take Sylva exit # 85. Go to the third light and Turn LEFT on to Hwy 107 going south, you will go through the little community of Sylva.

If you need groceries, pick them up in Sylva. It is a long way back to town, about 35 minutes, and there aren't any stores close to Arrowmont. In Sylva:

- There is a Food Lion shortly after you get off hwy 74/23.
- There is a Wal-Mart Super Center after you turn left at the third light and go about 2 -3 miles on your right.
- Ingles Grocery is about a mile beyond the Super Wal-Mart on the right.

Continue south on Hwy 107 toward Western Carolina University and Cullowhee. In Cullowhee there are 4 lights on hwy 107.

At the fourth light turn Right on to Cullowhee Mountain Road at Cullowhee Valley Elementary School. It is a 2 lane, twisty country road that will take twice as long to travel a mile as it does in the city.

The road forks about a mile from HWY 107...STAY TO THE LEFT and go about another 8 miles up Cullowhee Mountain Road. You will be going all the way to the top of the mountain and will probably think you are lost. An easy way to tell how far you've traveled up the road is by watching the mailbox numbers. They will tell you the mileage. If you see the number 500 on a mailbox, you have traveled a half a mile. If you see the number 7000 on a mailbox, you have traveled 7 miles. You need to travel to 8900 to get to Arrowmont.

At the top you will see 2 country churches. On your left is Double Springs Church of God and on your right is a "cemetery church". Go 1 mile beyond these two churches to Arrowmont Trail on your left.

Turn left on Arrowmont Trail into Arrowmont Stables & Cabins entrance. You will come to a gate that may be closed to keep the horses in. Open the gate, come through and close the gate behind you. From the gate you will see the stables and Cabin Reservation check-in which is in the stables reception office.

Plan about 5 hours from Raleigh to Arrowmont Stables & Cabins.
